James R. Stauffer and Scott M. Johnson

INDICATIONS

Patients with symptomatic cervical disk degeneration need to receive disk decompression and artificial replacement of the cervical discs.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Cervical instability and gross disc degeneration (e.g., 50% of original volume or greater) with or without myelopathy or radicular compression
- Previous cervical laminectomy and fusion (decreased bone stock)

POSITION OF PATIENT AND SURGEON

- Supine patient with neck degeneration
- Head tilted to one side
- Head repositioned to midline (cervical traction)
- Cervical traction
- Cervical collar

Imaging/Imaging

- History and physical examination findings (e.g., pain, radiculopathy, paresthesia)
- Cervical preoperative evaluation of both cervical function (e.g., cervical spine and cervical spine using a cervical computed tomography (CT), and magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) to rule out cervical (Fig. 8-1A and 8-1B and 8-1C))
- Cervical spine radiographs (postoperative or before decompression) (Fig. 8-2).
