Proudfoot's work challenges many previously held assumptions about the character of the landowning minority and its role in Ireland's economic, social and political history. It is demonstrated that, contrary to what some historians have asserted, landlords were not the supreme arbiters of local life in Ireland and that the landlord's choice of action was limited by economic circumstance and local social attitudes and political opinions. Proudfoot also shows that the relationship between successive dukes and their tenants was characterized by a surprising degree of tacit collaboration as each party sought to profit from the maintenance of what were essentially mutually beneficial tenurial ties. The eventual weakening of these ties owed far more to national events than to any inherent contradictions in the landlord-tenant relationship itself. *Urban Patronage* opens up new avenues of approach to the study of urban estates in Ireland and, in so doing, tests and challenges many accepted notions about the actions and motivations of Irish landlords. Because it adds significantly to our understanding of the role and influence of the landed aristocracy in the urban communities of eighteenth and nineteenth century Ireland, it will be of particular interest to scholars and advanced students specializing in Irish history, cultural studies or historical geography. Lindsay Proudfoot is reader in geography at Queen's University Belfast, where he has taught since 1977. He has published extensively in the field of Irish historical geography and is the coeditor of *An Historical Geography of Ireland* (1993).
