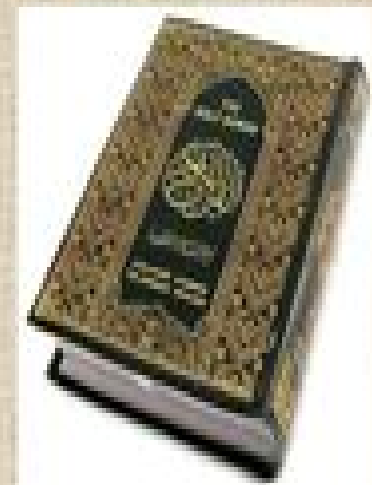


# The Origins of Islam
