which men and women communicate We illustrate those differences by presenting anecdotes highlighting the common experience women have of sometimes being shut out of conversations particularly ones that are about male topics Science tells us that there are various stages or statuses of racial identity and we present some prototypical anecdotes that illustrate how those statuses of racial identity affect one's perceptions and life experiences Science tells us that clients of color now referred to as BIPOC for Black Indigenous and People of Color may have very different reactions to European American therapists and we present an anecdote that conveys a typical reaction to a European American therapist who did not approach a BIPOC family of color in a culturally sensitive manner Again these stories are meant not to replace science but to enrich science to add texture to the clean and sometimes sterile lines of science
