

In her penetrating new study *Na ama Rokem* observes that prose writing more than poetry drama or other genres came to signify a historic rift that resulted in loss and disenchantment. In *Prosaic Conditions* Rokem treats prose as a signifying practice that is a practice that creates meaning. Focusing on the scientific, psychological and experimental tactics of symbolism, *Nature's Experiments and the Search for Symbolist Form* demystifies the avant garde value of experimentation and reveals new and important insights into a foundational period for the development of European modernism.
