He also shows that nature conservation is mostly not exactly what the term says in essence protection of nature. Often aesthetic aspects of a landscape section are also in the foreground when designating it as a natural monument or nature reserve. Moreover nature conservation runs the risk of becoming a substitute action and an alibi for a still growing destruction of traditional and near natural landscape systems in Central Europe as well as globally. The updated second edition now explicitly includes the consequences of climate change for nature conservation and has also incorporated a stronger reference to Austria as well as to the central Alpine region in some places for the relevant readers.
