The new arrivals were welcomed for their strong work ethic so long as they stayed in invisible spheres such as fieldwork but were resented once they began to take part in more public activities like schools or town meetings. Several chapters, including Mark Grey and Anne Woodrick's examination of a small Iowa town, point to the importance of dialogue and mediation in establishing amicable relations between ethnic groups in newly multi-cultural settings.
