Moore explores how metaphysics can help us to cope with continually changing demands on our humanity by making sense of things in ways that are radically new

Idea and Ontology Marc A. Hight, 2008-07-21 The prevailing view about the history of early modern philosophy which the author dubs the early modern tale and wants to convince us is really a fairy tale has it that the focus on ideas as a solution to various epistemological puzzles first introduced by Descartes created difficulties for the traditional ontological scheme of substance and mode. The early modern tale depicts the development of the way of ideas as abandoning ontology at least by the time of Berkeley.
