



Instead, he saw something else: a tiny, steady pinprick of light moving right alongside the planet. He watched it carefully over the next few nights and realized it was orbiting Neptune. He had discovered Neptune's first moon. Lassell named it Triton after the son of the Greek sea god. It was an amazing discovery to make so quickly but Triton is so big that it was the easiest of Neptune's secrets to find. After that incredible start, the story of Neptune went quiet. For years and years, astronomers looked at the planet but all they ever saw was the big blue world and its one giant moon, Triton. A whole century passed. That's one hundred years of looking and finding nothing new. It seemed like Neptune was a lonely place. While planets like Jupiter and Saturn had whole families of moons, Neptune just had Triton. Scientists began to wonder if there was anything else hiding in the darkness. Neptune is so far from the Sun that it receives very little light. Any other moons would likely be much smaller and darker than Triton, making them almost impossible to see in the glare of the giant planet.
