Kierkegaard makes this point repeatedly in his journals and indeed the preface of a work he published a few years after *Works of Love* begins with the words *My dear reader If possible read aloud If you do so let me thank you for it* While previous translations have not given sufficient attention to this critical aural aspect of the text Bruce H Kirmmse's translation preserves it thus making the same request of its readers that Kierkegaard once made of his to hear the argument by reading it aloud.
