

Moving beyond 'models' of dual language bilingual education: From oversimplification to decision-making processes at all scales

What this research was about and why it is important

This theoretical article, with recommendations for practice, looks at how scholars and educators discuss dual language bilingual education (DLBE) models in the United States, with international implications for bilingual, immersion, and CLIL contexts. We rethink the equity problems and potentials of so-called 'program models' and 'language allocation.' We describe three inequitable oversimplifications that stem from what we call *models-talk*—the oversimplified ways in which the dominant definitions of 'program models' structure much of the DLBE conversation. What we offer as an alternative is a framework that can help educators and scholars more easily embrace the complexity of the full spectrum of decision-making involved in allocating language(s) and how to assess its degree of equity. Our framework recommends thinking of DLBE practice as three decision-making processes: grouping by students' linguistic repertoires, alternating and connecting language(s), and allotting content and time to language(s).

What the researchers did

We help DLBE practitioners and researchers rethink the equity problems and potentials of so-called 'program models' and 'language allocation' as aspects of what we call *linguistic resource strategy*—the various language-related resources that language users strategize their use of.

- *Discourse*: Choosing a discourse likely to be persuasive or recontextualizing/ combining discourses in novel ways.
- *Languages of instruction and students' home languages or varieties*: Choosing when and how to use more than one language or variety as a means of clarifying or expanding new knowledge and empowering learners.
- *An individual's language repertoire*: Choosing combinations that will likely make sense to the audience or signal group membership.
- *Teaching materials*: Choosing to whom or to what to expose learners to or expose oneself as a learner.

What the researchers found

- **Oversimplification of What's Inside: Models-Talk Abstracts from the Complexities of DLBE Decision Making:** Models-talk continues to oversimplify language allocation processes in DLBE by only focusing on two:
 - The share of time given to the languages of instruction (ratio-based 'models') such as '50:50' or '90:10'
 - The linguistic repertoires of the student groups that programs intend to serve and the teachers they recruit (group-repertoire-based 'models') such as 'two-way' that tries to balance students who are new to the partner language with students who already speak it as a home language.
- **Oversimplification of Who Decides:** Models-talk privileges the macro scale, ignoring the role of teachers and students in decisions about allocating language.
- **Oversimplification of How Many Models Get to Talk:** Models-talk makes it easier to argue that some models should be dominant and excluded others, which limits the responsiveness of DLBE to the particular communities.

Things to consider

Building on theories of translanguaging and a retheorizing of linguistic resources and repertoires, this framework for language allocation conceptualizes three decision-making processes:

- **Grouping by Students' Linguistic Repertoires:**
 - Allocating students' varied linguistic resources across groups that are either short-term or long-term
 - Alternating and Connecting Language(s)
 - Allotting Content and Time to Language(s)
- The final section of our article identifies questions to drive equity-centered planning: Macro (government/district, school, and program policy), Meso (planned curriculum, instruction, and materials), Micro (in-the-moment implementation decisions).
