El texto de Louis I. Kahn es, en principio, una descripción un tanto poética del su proyecto del Museo Kimbell pero, si lo leemos con atención, sería más bien un alegato en favor de la luz natural.

La luz natural establece una pauta al arquitecto la relación entre arquitectura y naturaleza. Frente a una luz artificial siempre estática, para mostrarla el flujo de las horas y de las estaciones, por lo que se trata de un principio básico del que siempre se ha servido la arquitectura.

Este escrito que nos ocupa muestra cómo Louis Kahn se refiere a estas cuestiones en un tono absolutamente autorreferencial. Es la voz del arquitecto que se expresa como autor y lo hace en un estilo dialogante consigo mismo y de carta postica, mediante el cual pretende explicar el proyecto en tanto que arquitectura fundamentada en su relación con la luz natural.

Kahn trata, en primer lugar, de salir al paso de una tendencia que ya se venía imponiendo por la cual la arquitectura de los museos debía fundarse en un control lumínico muy determinado en esos temas de la protección de los objetos expuestos, como de la adecuada pervivencia de los mismos, en particular de las obras pictóricas que se determinan en contacto con la luz indirecta.

Esta tendencia podría haberse consolidado plenamente en manos de museólogos y otros agentes que actualmente controlan la arquitectura museística, pero en tiempos de Kahn, que contaba además con un cliente
