"customary law": the traditional regulatory practices of a specific society, for example Māori customary law.

New Zealand's Legal arena has rocked between various systems. In 1858 the *English Laws Act* was passed. The Act stated that all applicable English Law (1840 and prior) was inherited. Prior to this, after the signing of the treaty, NZ was operating on English Law by assumption. Before English settlers arrived, New Zealand had Maori customary law, which had operated in New Zealand since the arrival of Polynesian voyagers approximately 600 years before.

There were several steps taken for NZ to become a colony.
