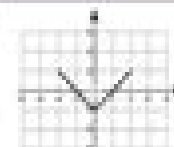


1) The point $P(-4, 5)$ lies on the circumference of a circle with centre $(1, -3)$. Find an equation of the tangent to the circle at point P .

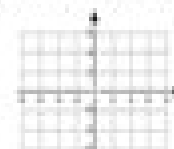
2) a) Write $x^2 - 4x + 11$ in the form $(x - a)^2 + b$.

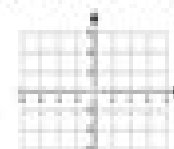
3) The graph of $y = f(x)$ is shown on the grid.

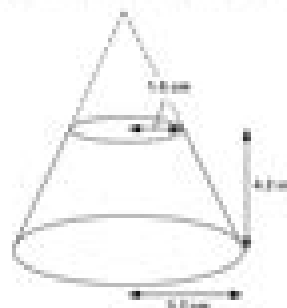

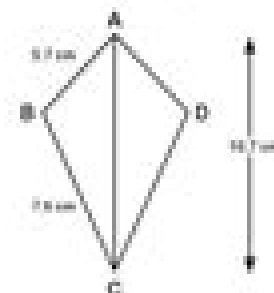
