convincingly defends such approaches against objections that they make an illegitimate appeal to introspection Experiences that are conscious in Siewert's sense differ from each other in ways that only what is conscious can in phenomenal character and having this character gives them intentionality In Siewert's view consciousness is involved not only in the intentionality of sense experience and imagery but in that of nonimagistic ways of thinking as well Consciousness is pervasively bound up with intelligent perception and conceptual thought it is not mere sensation or raw feel Having thus understood consciousness we can better recognize how for many of us it possesses such deep intrinsic value that life without it would be little or no better than death
