The Nature of the Law and Related Legal Writings Eric Voegelin, 1991 During the course of his lifelong wide ranging reflections on history and philosophy Eric Voegelin naturally was drawn to speculate on the nature of law This volume consists of many of Voegelin s significant writings in this area most notably the previously unpublished *The Nature of the Law* Voegelin completed *The Nature of the Law* in 1957 while he was a member of the political science faculty of Louisiana State University and teaching a course in jurisprudence at the university s law school In it he undertakes a philosophical analysis of the law to determine its nature or essence and comes to the conclusion that the law does not exist as a discrete entity but instead constitutes the structure of a society The law as Voegelin s analysis reveals is not simply the command of a Leviathan handed down to others Nor is it simply the result of a social compact among autonomous individuals or the expressed will of a majority securing its own self defined immediate worldly interest It is rather a part of the order that a society discovers and specifies for itself in the effort to secure the common good Thus laws and legal order have an integral relation with the society that declares them for in declaring laws the society in some sense structures itself Also included in this volume is Voegelin s detailed outline for the jurisprudence course he taught at LSU from 1954 to 1957 The outline was distributed to Voegelin s students but otherwise has not been published In this outline Voegelin is concerned more with the criteria for legal order than he is with the nature of law Voegelin also prepared for his jurisprudence course supplementary notes that are essentially a compact statement of his views on the law and the editors have included those notes here Finally the book contains reviews written by Voegelin in 1941 and 1942 of four books on legal science and legal philosophy *The Elements of Law, Natural and Politic* Thomas Hobbes, 2022-05-29 In *The Elements of Law Natural and Politic* Thomas Hobbes explores the foundation of political philosophy through a meticulous examination of human nature morality and the structure of society Written in a clear yet intricate style this treatise unpacks the social contract theory laying the groundwork for modern political thought Hobbes employs a rationalist approach interweaving his insights into natural law with an analysis of governance ultimately arguing for the necessity of a powerful sovereign to maintain order and prevent conflict among self interested individuals This work is situated within the broader context of 17th century Enlightenment thinking reflecting the tumultuous political landscape of his time particularly the English Civil War Thomas Hobbes an influential philosopher was deeply affected by the chaos of his era which instilled in him a profound distrust of human nature and a recognition of the inherent violence in humanity s quest for survival His early experiences particularly witnessing the breakdown of social order galvanized his thoughts on the need for strong political authority As a student of Aristotle s works Hobbes melded classical philosophy with emerging Enlightenment ideals which undoubtedly informed his vision in *The Elements of Law* This seminal

The conclusion brings the debates about natural law and justice together as parallel efforts to understand the human condition. The existence and grounding of human or natural rights is a heavily contested issue today not only in the West but in the debates raging between fundamentalists and liberals or modernists in the Islamic world. This book focuses on three bodies of theory that developed between the thirteenth and seventeenth centuries: 1. the foundational belief in the existence of a moral/juridical natural law embodying universal norms of right and wrong and accessible to natural human reason; 2. the understanding of scientific uniformities of nature as divinely imposed laws which rose to prominence in the seventeenth century; and 3. finally the notion that individuals are bearers of inalienable natural or human rights. While seen today as distinct bodies of theory often locked in mutual conflict, they grew up inextricably intertwined. The book argues that they cannot be properly understood if taken each in isolation from the others.

Morality and the Nature of Law Kenneth Einar Himma, 2019. Morality and the Nature of Law explores the conceptual relationship between morality and the criteria that determine what counts as law in a given society: the criteria of legal validity. Is it necessary for a legal system to include moral criteria of legal validity? Is it even possible for a legal system to have moral criteria of legal validity? The book considers the views of natural law theorists ranging from Blackstone to Dworkin and rejects them, arguing that it is not conceptually necessary that the criteria of legal validity include moral norms. Further, it rejects the exclusive positivist view, arguing instead that it is conceptually possible for the criteria of validity to include moral norms. In the process of considering such questions, this book considers Raz's views concerning the nature of authority and Shapiro's views about the guidance function of law, which have been thought to repudiate the conceptual possibility of moral criteria of legal validity. The book then articulates a thought experiment that shows that it is possible for a legal system to have such criteria and concludes with a chapter that argues that any legal system like that of the United States, which affords final authority over the content of the law to judges who are fallible with respect to the requirements of morality, is a legal system with purely source-based criteria of validity.
