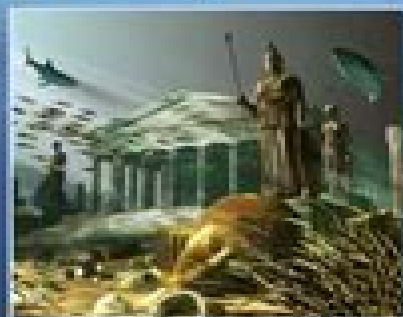

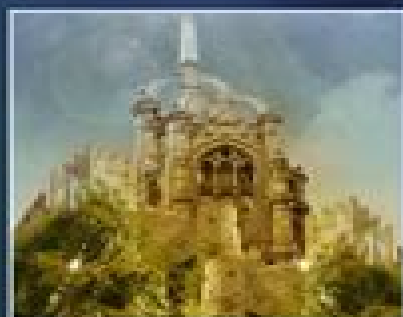

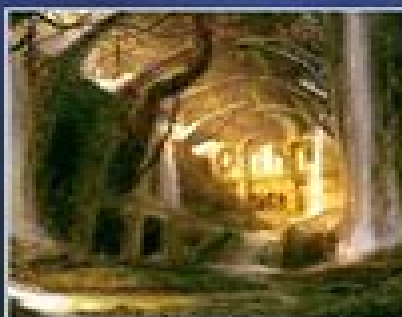
Lemuria: Lost Continent

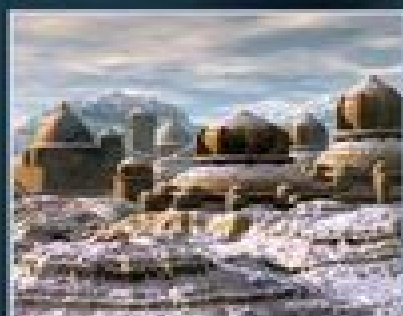

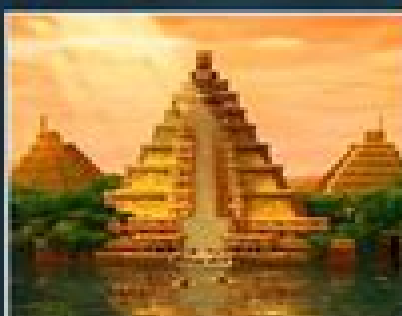

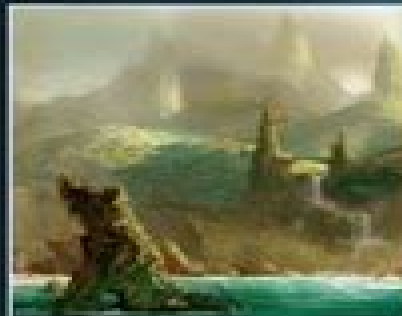
