

NEONATAL SKIN VARIATIONS

Dermal melanocytosis – aka "Mongolian spots" is a type of birthmark found in newborns at birth or within the first few days of life. They present as blue or blue-gray spots on the back, buttocks, base of spine, shoulders, or other body areas. Usually **fades** and often mistaken for bruising.



Port Wine Stain – A **permanent** birthmark commonly seen on the face. They often begin pink and appear to darken as the child grows.



Milia – Small white bumps or small cysts on the skin, often called "baby acne" or "milk spots." This is a common and normal finding that will **disappear** on its own.



Café-au-lait Spots – light to dark brown pigmented birthmarks (resembling coffee w/milk) that appear on the skin at birth. Having a large amount (>6) of these spots may correlate with neurofibromatosis.



Lanugo – soft, fine hair that covers the body and limbs of a newborn. This is a normal finding & will **disappear** within the first few weeks of life.



Nevus Simplex – aka "stork bites" are caused by a stretching (dilation) of certain blood vessels and typically present on the eyelids, back of the neck and forehead. They are most often **temporary**.
