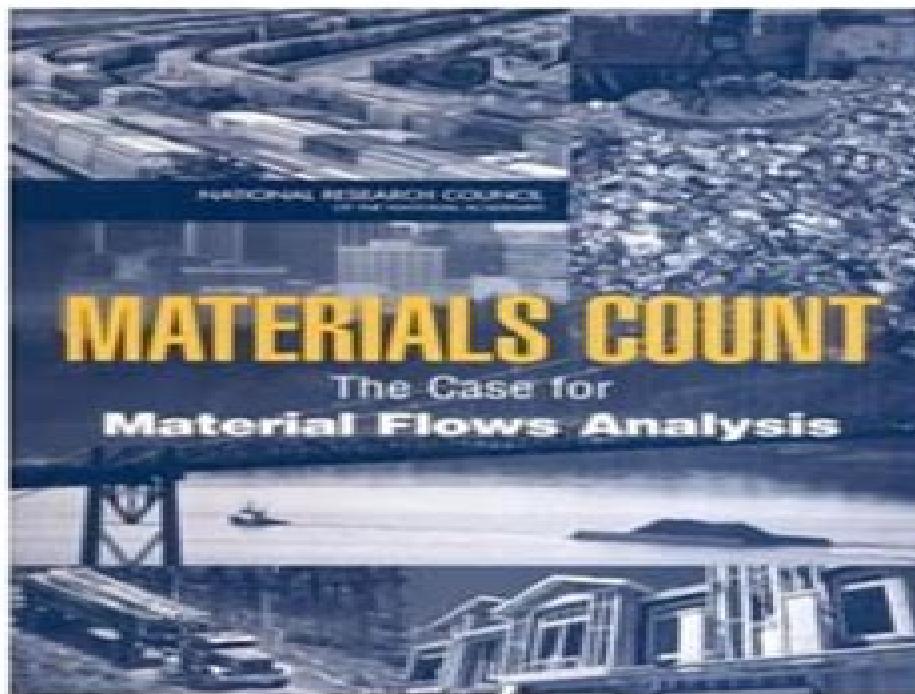

Sustainability (SU) and sustainable development (SD) are critical for survival of humanity but fraught with both definitional and measurement issues. SU and SD are complex multidimensional processes exhibiting i) social, cultural and economic variabilities, ii) a lack of unified definition and iii) conceptual vagueness.
