Multicultural Politics of Recognition and Postcolonial Citizenship Rachel Busbridge, 2017-07-20 This book examines claims for recognition of cultural difference from immigrant and Indigenous minorities highlighting the ways in which they intersect with ideas of national community Busbridge argues that there is an important albeit under explored relationship between nation and multicultural politics of recognition Drawing on the Australian context the book explores how nation features as a productive if somewhat ambivalent discursive resource in contemporary Muslim and Aboriginal struggles to be recognised In demanding recognition minorities enter into the business of making the nation by positing alternative conceptions of national identity culture and belonging that are more attentive to their differences and claims This dynamic is engaged as an expression of postcolonial citizenship Postcolonial citizenship is imagined in terms of the ways in which minority groups actualise multicultural realities through rewriting ideas of national community It underlines the critical importance of revising the power relations that deem some groups more national and others less so and which in Western multicultural societies are typically tied to notions of the West and its others This book is an important conceptual theoretical and political intervention that brings postcolonialism and multiculturalism into dialogue on the increasingly potent issues of nation and national identity It will be of great interest to scholars and students of sociology politics postcolonial studies culture identity and nation
