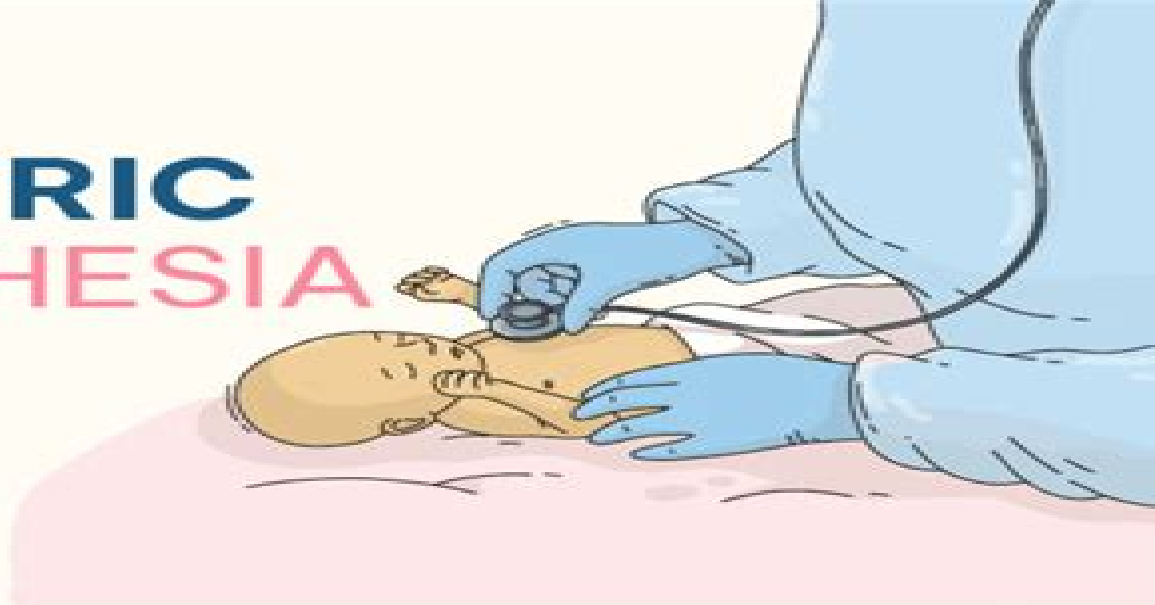

ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY

There are lots of anatomic differences between infants and adults which need to be accounted for properly in order to safely manage an infant's airway as anaesthetic risk is higher in infants than in adult surgical patients:

Head	Larger occiput in infant naturally positions head in a flexed 'sniffing' position
Mouth	Larger tongue/mouth volume ratio in infant reduces available space for instrumentation Edentulous
Neck	Larynx more cephalad in neck in infants Epiglottis is omega shaped and longer Vocal cords slant caudally at the arytenoids Narrowest part of upper airway is cricoid ring covered by pseudostratified columnar epithelium Trachea is short 4-5 cm
Tracheobronchial tree	Acute angle of right mainstem bronchus at the carina Turbulent gas flow until the 5th bronchial division
