Digestive organs — Digesting or processing a traumatic experience

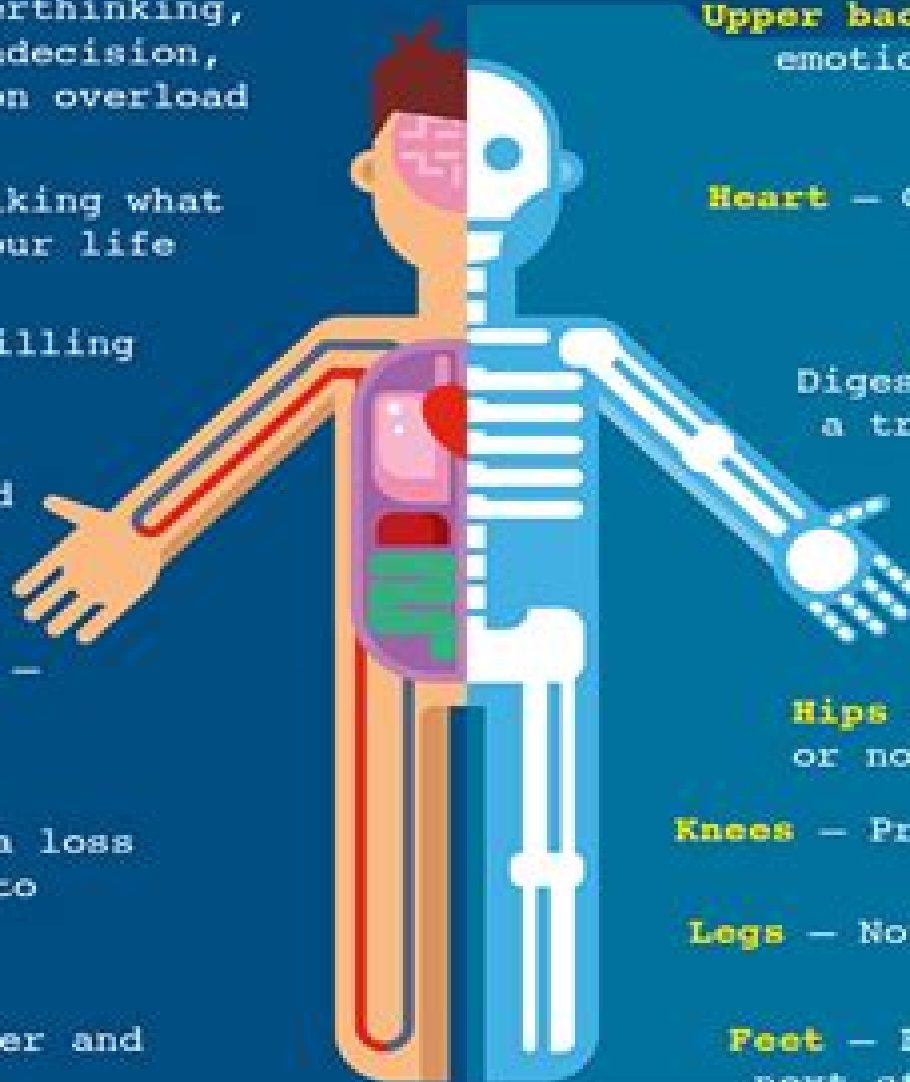
Stomach — Fear and anxiety
