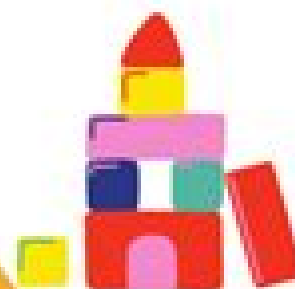

In Cambodia, trauma lingering from the Khmer Rouge era genocide combined with that produced by compounded social issues including child sexual abuse, human trafficking, and gender-based violence (GBV) contribute to one of the highest rates in the world of what a Western diagnostic model would define as PTSD. Such imbricated realities in Cambodia remain stigmatized, taboo, and misunderstood within Khmer society, oftentimes hindering the healing process for survivors at the individual and community levels. NGOs analyzed in this study seek to provide psychological and psychosocial support to those experiencing trauma from these events and concurrently promote education on these issues.
