computational models into simulations of actual cognitive change they become tangible entities that are accessible to systematic study. Unfortunately little of what has been produced has been published in journals or books where many professionals would easily find them. Feeling that developmental psychologists should be exposed to this relatively new approach a symposium was organized at the biennial meeting of the Society for Research in Child Development. The cost of entry was that speakers had to have a running computational model of a documented cognitive transition.
