language is so varied and evolves so quickly Yet fifty years after Shannon's study language models remain by all measures far from the Shannon entropy limit in terms of their predictive power However this has not kept them from being useful for a variety of text processing tasks and moreover can be viewed as encouragement that there is still great room for improvement in statistical language modeling
