*Next to the North wind* Kurt Lütgen, Maria Pelikan, 1973      **The Struggle for the South Atlantic: The Armada of the Strait, 1581-84** Carla Rahn Phillips, 2017-07-14 The Armada of the Strait under Don Diego Flores de Valdés in 1581-84 came at a crucial juncture in global politics. Philip II of Spain had assumed the crown of Portugal and its overseas empire and Francis Drake's daring peacetime raids had challenged the dominance of Spain and Portugal in the Americas. The armada was intended to ensure the loyalty of Portuguese Brazil, bolster its defences against hostile native peoples and English and French pirates and interlopers, and fortify and settle the Strait of Magellan to prevent further incursions into the Pacific. Pedro de Rada, the official scribe of the armada, kept a detailed neutral chronicle of the venture which remained in private hands until 1999 but is now held in the Henry E. Huntington Library in San Marino, California. It is published here for the first time. Previous historical assessments of the expedition have largely reflected the writings of Pedro Sarmiento de Gamboa, governor designate for the planned colony at the Strait who blamed all the misfortunes of the enterprise on Diego Flores de Valdés. Rada's *Relación* is presented here in conjunction with other documentation and compared with Sarmiento de Gamboa's accusations. The results will force scholars to revise long-standing conclusions regarding the place of Sarmiento and Flores in Spanish history and the accomplishments of a long-forgotten armada sent into the terrifying waters of the South Atlantic.

**Concerning Aristotle's On Animals (The Fathers of the Church, Mediaeval Continuation, Volume 9)** Albertus, 2008. After the Latin translation of Aristotelian works outside the *logica vetus* began in earnest in twelfth century Spain it remained to Scholastic philosophers to assimilate the new materials. Although many individuals commented on the *logica nova* and on some of Aristotle's books on natural philosophy, Albert the Great is one of only a very few Scholastics to comment on the entire collection of Aristotle's biological works. This text, the *Questions concerning Aristotle's On Animals*, *Quaestiones super de animalibus*, recovered only at the beginning of the twentieth century and never before translated in its entirety, represents Conrad of Austria's report on a series of disputed questions that Albert the Great addressed in Cologne ca. 1258. The *Questions* in nineteen books mixes two distinct genres: the scholastic *quaestio* with arguments *pro et contra*, a determination and answers to the objections, and the straightforward question and response found for example in The Prose Salernitan *Questions*. Here even more clearly perhaps than in his slightly later and much larger paraphrastic commentary *On Animals De animalibus*, Albert adduces his own views often criticizing other medieval physicians and natural philosophers on comparative anatomy, human physiology, sexuality, procreation, and embryology. that appeared in the Cologne edition of Albert's work helps to explain the title patron saint of scientists bestowed upon Albert by Pope Pius XII. This work should find its audience among medievalists and historians of science and culture. More so than the massive *On Animals* it should prove useful in the classroom as an encyclopedia or handbook of medieval life.
