**Markets Or Governments** Charles Wolf, 1988-01-01 Economic studies historically have either extolled the virtues of perfect markets or decried the market's shortcomings proposing that governments correct market failure. This book proposes as a counterweight to these views a theory of nonmarket failure and examines in great detail the shortcomings of government efforts to replace or to regulate markets. It is an unusually thorough analysis that can be used to make more systematic comparisons between markets and governments and to arrive at more intelligent choices between them. Wolf concludes that while both markets and governments have inherent shortcomings and the choice between them is never a pure one, real world situations always involve some combination of the two alternatives: markets do a better job than governments. They are more efficient according to both static and dynamic criteria. With respect to equity and other non-efficiency considerations, however, both markets and governments have strengths and weaknesses. Finally, Wolf points out that government can play an important role in improving and extending the functioning of markets. And perhaps most controversially, he argues that market forces themselves can play an important role in improving the functioning of government. They can reduce the incidence of nonmarket failure by injecting market incentives into government operations.
