Robert Francis Jones, 1999 Thus his log is the most accurate account of the daily activity of the trading post Jacket      **The People Are Dancing Again** Charles Wilkinson, 2012-02-01 The history of the Siletz is in many ways the history of all Indian tribes in America a story of heartache perseverance survival and revival It began in a resource rich homeland thousands of years ago and today finds a vibrant modern community with a deeply held commitment to tradition The Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians twenty seven tribes speaking at least ten languages were brought together on the Oregon Coast through treaties with the federal government in 1853 55 For decades after the Siletz people lost many traditional customs saw their languages almost wiped out and experienced poverty killing diseases and humiliation Again and again the federal government took great chunks of the magnificent timber rich tribal homeland a reservation of 1 1 million acres reaching a full 100 miles north to south on the Oregon Coast By 1956 the tribe had been terminated under the Western Oregon Indian Termination Act selling off the remaining land cutting off federal health and education benefits and denying tribal status Poverty worsened and the sense of cultural loss deepened The Siletz people refused to give in In 1977 after years of work and appeals to Congress they became the second tribe in the nation to have its federal status its treaty rights and its sovereignty restored Hand in glove with this federal recognition of the tribe has come a recovery of some land several hundred acres near Siletz and 9 000 acres of forest and a profound cultural revival This remarkable account written by one of the nation s most respected experts in tribal law and history is rich in Indian voices and grounded in extensive research that includes oral tradition and personal interviews It is a book that not only provides a deep and beautifully written account of the history of the Siletz but reaches beyond region and tribe to tell a story that will inform the way all of us think about the past Watch the book trailer <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NEtAIGxp6pc>      **Uncertain Encounters** Nathan Douthit, 2002 Finally it describes the removal of Indians to the Siletz and Grand Ronde reservations as told from the perspective of Indian oral narratives as well as white accounts As a major aspect of the story Douthit highlights the development of a little known middle ground of relationships between Indian women and white men during and after removal **BOOK JACKET**      **San Francisco Lithographer** Robert J. Indigenous employees of HBC were permitted to rise beyond the rank of postmaster After leaving the company in 1878 McKay began a second career in the Department of Indian Affairs He was a federal Indian Agent and later the Assistant Commissioner of Indian Affairs for British Columbia A product of his time who had found personal success working within the colonial system McKay is a complicated figure when viewed through a twenty first century lens He advocated on behalf of Indigenous Peoples when he tried to prevent the trespass of CPR crews and European settlers on their ancestral land Between 1886 and 1888 he personally inoculated more than a thousand Indigenous people with the smallpox vaccine Yet he also participated in a system that did untold harm to First Nations M tis and Inuit people This fascinating new biography sheds light on an accomplished and complex man **Oregon Geographic Names** Lewis Ankeny McArthur,1928 **The Journal of American History** Organization of American historians,1997 Arts & Humanities Citation Index ,1997
