



A life-course approach to assessing residential mobility dynamics in selected immigrant communities in Kumasi, Ghana

ABSTRACT

This paper responds to the emerging concerns of residential dissonance character by examining the position and influence of the "life-course" framework of households on residential mobility decisions and the concurrent attainment of subjective well-being in their current and anticipated residential locations. Using data from a cross-sectional survey design and adopting a multi-stage sampling procedure, a comparative study of 3997 households from immigrant communities within the Kumasi metropolis is conceptualized. Results from the study revealed contrasting variabilities in the push and pull factors influencing households' relocation experiences and decisions to move. Also, the likelihood of households relocating over the life course was significantly anchored on the employment stage. Thus, decision-making processes for households' relocations, intentions, preparations, and realizing actual moves were noticeably rapid decisions during active employment life. The study further found that the associated perception of attaining subjective well-being attached to a household's anticipated residential locations was significantly higher than that of their current residence. On the premise of these empirical contributions, the paper outlines how findings could ultimately inform the development of sustainable urban growth management and shape housing mobility planning policies for rapidly growing regions within the global south.

1. Introduction

Urbanization, as discussed by some scholars (e.g., *Anas & Rhee*, 2006; *Parikh & Malhotra*, 2011) is a multidimensional phenomenon (economically, environmentally, sociologically and demographically) that has the potential of either obstructing or promoting the development and growth of places due to the influx of people in urban areas. Theoretically, *Cohenhead & Ellwanger* (2013) assert that urbanization should promote socio-economic progress and lead to human improvement. In contrast, other scholars argue that it retards socio-economic progress and interferes with urban efficiency. As *Collins et al.* (2004) indicated, this paradoxical phenomenon affects all nations and is mainly brought on by population expansion, economic development, and infrastructural projects. Currently, one in every five persons globally resides in a city with a population of over one million (*United Nations*, 2014a). The spectacle of this explosive urban growth phenomenon becomes more critical for the future of urban growth management as the *World Bank* (2017) anticipates 2 billion more urban residents to be added to cities by 2045. Underlying the pending stress of this urban multiplicity, the *World Bank* (2016) has advised that developing

countries brace themselves for the tripling of their built-up urban areas by some 400,000 square kilometers by 2030 (see Table 1).

Despite the rapidly surging global population phenomena, a critical underlying component that serves as a central puzzle to understanding this spectacle is the decisions of the key actors (housing policies, households, and firms) on land use, co-location, and transport interaction choice sets. These actors are faced with tough decisions, especially in the urban land use domain, where the premium value of land and space keep rising considerably. *Winkell* (2011) affirms this assertion to the effect that, essential among the processes underlying the observed structural changes in cities are the location decisions of actors in the urban housing and employment markets. Therefore, understanding the dynamics of residential mobility becomes imperative as residential development stands tall as the leading global driver of land use change with the largest share of all land uses in urban areas (*Liu & Robinson*, 2016; *Poole-Dowell*, 2021).

As cities grow and land use and human interactions become more complex, the resultant changes in the spatial structure, land use configuration, and socio-economic attractiveness of cities cause a redistribution of urban households at certain points in time (Orey &
