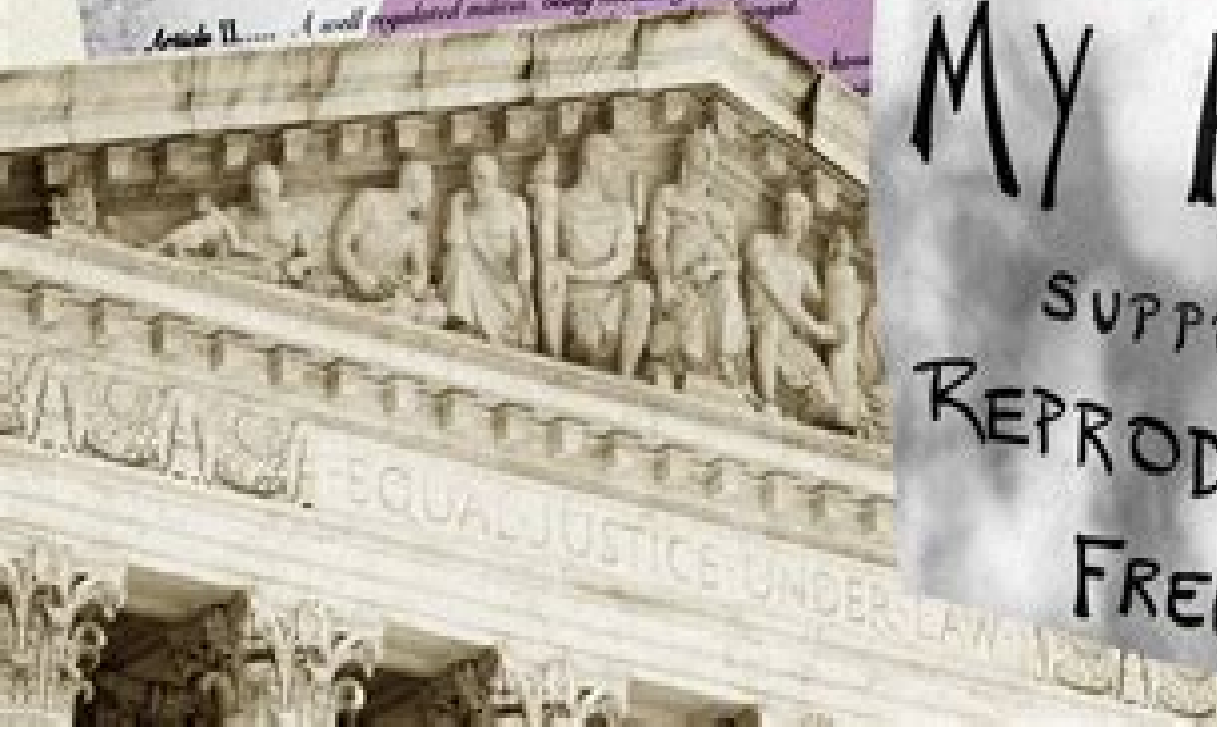
*Article I..... Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the
