New Developments in Second Intermediate Period Archaeology in Egypt (ca. 1800–1550 BC)

In 2015 the project *Beyond Politics: Material Culture in Second Intermediate Period Egypt and Nubia*¹ was initiated to assess archaeological finds in their own right, independently from the historical, written sources. This approach was born out of necessity because the majority of archaeological finds do not bear dynastic affiliations. This is particularly true of the non-elite strata of ancient society.

The difficulties would not be alleviated even if such data were more frequent, because in the Second Intermediate Period (SIP) a) the sequence of pharaohs is not completely preserved²; b) the reconstruction is not agreed upon³ and c) numerous archaeological SIP sites do not include any king's names.

Most objects discussed here lack inscriptions or names, to demonstrate the complications and the need to add archaeological interpretations to obtain greater insight into the reconstruction of the lives of past people in the SIP. This is not to say that texts should be ignored, but the full value of archaeological finds should be used to add knowledge of the past.

1. PROJECT SCOPE AND CHRONOLOGICAL RANGE

The aims of the project are to undertake new analyses of material remains of the entire SIP, providing data for typical material culture in the various regions of Egypt (e.g. the eastern Delta, Memphis-Fayoum Region, Middle Egypt, Theban area, southern Egypt⁴). A representative selection of contexts from the quantity of available material is made.

In order to define the limitations of the SIP, differences to before and after need to be ascertained, thus the chronological range goes from the late Middle Kingdom (MK) to the beginning of the New Kingdom (NK). The transitional periods between the end of the MK and the SIP and the end
