American Apocrypha Dan Vogel, Brent Lee Metcalfe, 2002 In the preceding pages I have tried to show how a historical critical view of the Book of Mormon illuminates some of its more interesting problems Many questions remain and many problems have yet to be discovered and analyzed I myself have questions about the Book of Mormon's origins that I cannot yet answer However that fact does not diminish the certainty of my conclusion that the Book of Mormon is a modern text
