Architecture at its core is a cultural artifact that responds to its social, political, economic and environmental contexts and expresses a multitude of cultural beliefs and imperatives. Sacred architecture has historically reflected the symbolic, religious axioms, beliefs and rituals of particular cultures whose ultimate goal is some element of transcendence. The process with which sacred architecture is designed has lost much of its relevance for a culture that no longer adheres to faith-based world religions but still searches for a spiritual outlet. Rationalization has resulted in a fundamental need for space to be developed for those looking to address their disenchantment in a rationalized world. A psychological theory known as Flow, developed by the Hungarian psychologist Mihaly Csikszentmihalyi, argues that people are most happy and fulfilled when in a state of controlled consciousness where a person is fully immersed in the task at hand. This state might be better recognized as being in the zone, which leads to an autotelic or intrinsically rewarding experience. The flow theory, named for
