Many of the artists and sitters discussed were Anglo-Irish Protestants. Both Imperial and nationalist ideologues tended to devalue reading, especially fiction, as an unmanly occupation. Nonetheless, some men are depicted reading and failing to embody a manly attitude. The spread of the novel and the introduction of silent reading allowed women of the middle and upper classes, often Anglo-Irish, to engage with a range of imaginative reading materials secure from patriarchal surveillance. Visual images of women as serious readers drew on and contributed to the emergence of the New Woman in Ireland.
