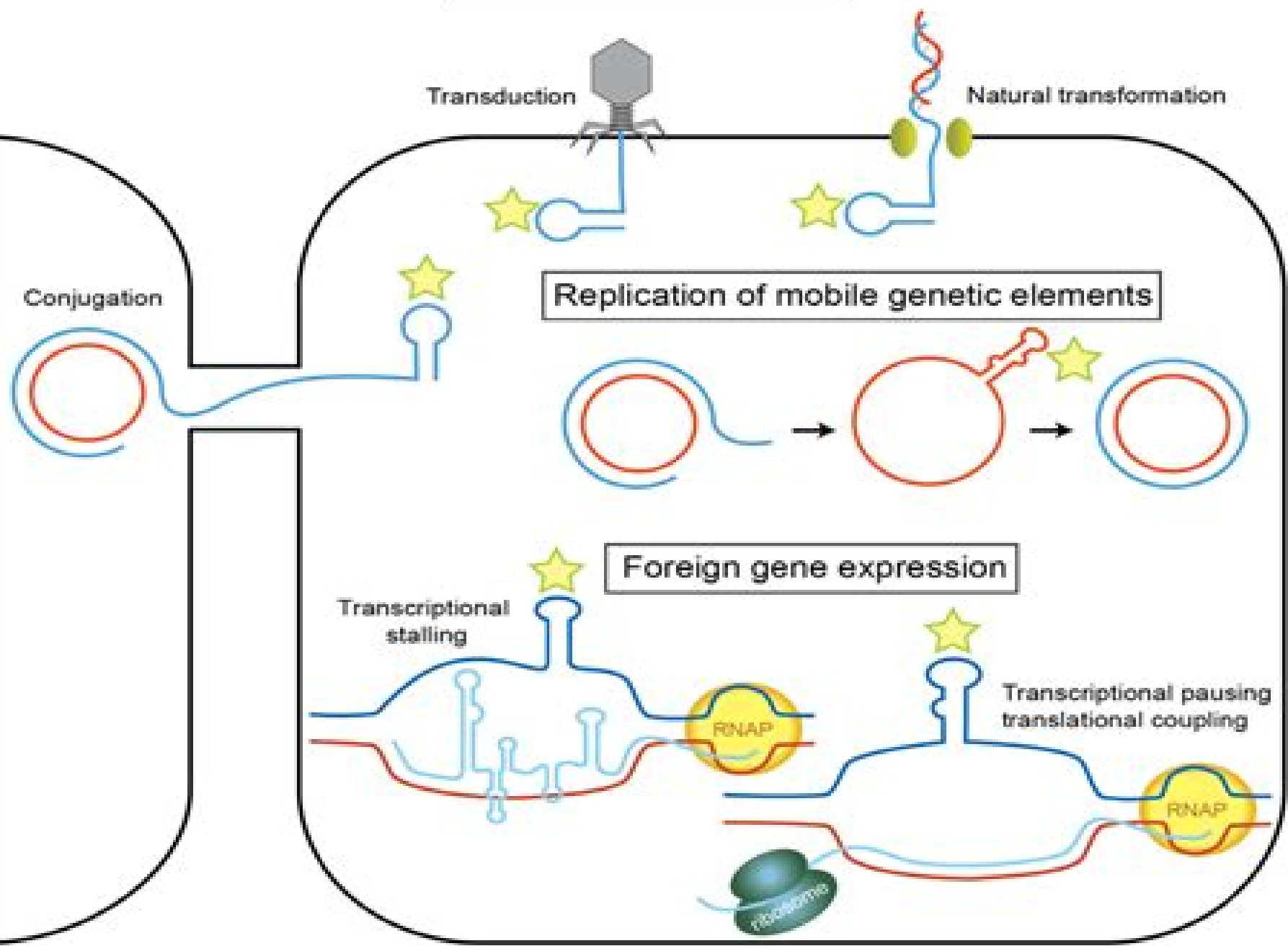

It attempts to make the biochemistry of DNA rearrangements more accessible to embryologists and evolutionists and to illuminate the related developmental cycles to the biochemist. The book also shows how natural the activity of mobile elements can be in diverse biological situations. The chapters describe several well studied cases in which genetic determinants often identified as specific nucleic acid sequences repeatedly change their positions within or between cellular genomes. Because their genomic positions are not fixed, these determinants may conveniently be classed together under the rubric of mobile genetic elements. The book begins with a discussion of maize controlling elements. This is followed by separate chapters on the bacteriophages and Mu nonviral mobile elements in bacteria transposable Ty elements in brewer's yeast, *Drosophila* transposable element and hybrid dysgenesis. Mobile Genetic Elements in Cellular Differentiation, Genome Stability, and Cancer Tammy A. Morrish, Jose Luis García Pérez, 2018-01-16

The human genome, as with the genome of most organisms, is comprised of various types of mobile genetic element derived repeats. Mobile genetic elements that mobilize by an RNA intermediate include both autonomous and non autonomous retrotransposons and mobilize by a copy and paste mechanism that relies on the presence of a functional reverse transcriptase activity. The extent to which these different types of elements are actively mobilizing varies among organisms as revealed with the advent of Next Generation DNA sequencing (NGS). To understand the normal and aberrant mechanisms that impact the mobility of these elements requires a more extensive understanding of how these elements interact with molecular pathways of the cell including DNA repair, recombination and chromatin. In addition, epigenetic based mechanisms can also influence the mobility of these elements, likely by transcriptional activation or repression in certain cell types. Studies regarding how mobile genetic elements interface and evolve with these pathways will rely on genomic studies from various model organisms. In addition, the mechanistic details of how these elements are regulated will continue to be elucidated with the use of genetic, biochemical, molecular, cellular and bioinformatic approaches. Remarkably, the current understanding regarding the biology of these elements in the human genome suggests these elements may impact developmental biology including cellular differentiation, neuronal development and immune function. Thus, aberrant changes in these molecular pathways may also impact disease including neuronal degeneration, autoimmunity and cancer.

Mobile Genetic Elements Matthew George Durrant, 2020 Mobile genetic elements MGEs are genetic material that can mobilize and move either within a single organism's genome or between the genomes of different organisms An integrative mobile genetic element is one that can merge its genetic material with other genetic molecules to form a single genetic molecule either DNA or RNA Thanks to the work of pioneering scientists such as Nobel Laureate Barbara McClintock our knowledge of how MGEs work and how they influence evolution has exploded and continues to grow to this day MGEs and the enzymes that enable their mobilization transposases recombinases integrases resolvases invertases etc have been adapted as useful experimental and therapeutic tools But there is still much to be learned about MGEs and in the age of next generation sequencing we have more tools than ever before to interrogate their function In chapter 2 this dissertation introduces software that analyzes next generation sequencing data to identify integrative mobile genetic elements and to genotype the precise genomic location of their insertion with respect to a reference genome This bioinformatics tool called MGEfinder is applied in an analysis of thousands of publicly available bacterial genomes and this analysis sheds light on how MGEs allow bacteria to adapt develop antibiotic resistance and become more virulent and dangerous to their human hosts In chapter 3 this tool and others are then adapted and used as a part of a genomic data mining pipeline to identify novel genetic elements and enzymes that have promise as genome engineering tools Thousands of these site specific integrases also described as recombinases were identified and stored in a database and they were curated and prioritized to identify those that hold promise as human genome editing tools specifically Early validation experiments are promising In addition to studies that focus on this main theme of mobile genetic elements this dissertation introduces additional works related to the identification of small open reading frames smORFs in microbial genomes chapter 4 and the transcriptomic and epigenomic response of a colorectal cancer cell line to the microbial metabolite butyrate chapter 5 Together these chapters demonstrate the importance of developing and applying tools to the study of mobile genetic elements more broadly indicating the great scientific and therapeutic potential of these ubiquitous genetic elements

Role of Mobile Genetic Elements in the Global Network of Bacterial Horizontal Gene Transfer Mislav Acman, 2022 Many bacteria can exchange genetic material through horizontal gene transfer HGT mediated by plasmids and plasmid borne transposable elements One grave consequence of this exchange is the rapid spread of antibiotic resistance determinants among bacterial communities across the world In this thesis I make use of large datasets of publicly available bacterial genomes and various analytical approaches to improve our understanding of the nature and the impact of HGT at a global scale In the first part I study the population structure and dynamics of over 10 000 bacterial plasmids By reconstructing and analysing a network of plasmids based on their shared k mer content I was able to sort them into biologically meaningful clusters This network based analysis allowed me to make further inferences into global network of HGT and opened up prospect for a natural and exhaustive classification framework of bacterial plasmids The

second part focuses on global spreading of blaNDM an important antibiotic resistance gene To this end I compiled a dataset of over 6000 bacterial genomes harbouring this element and developed a novel computational approach to track structural variants surrounding blaNDM across bacterial genomes This facilitated identification of prevalent genomic contexts of blaNDM and reconstruction of key mobile genetic elements and events which led to its global dissemination Taken together my results highlight transposable elements as the main drivers of HGT at broad phylogenetic and geographical scales with plasmid exchange being much more spatially restricted due to the adaptation to specific bacterial hosts and evolutionary pressures

Interactions Between Mobile Genetic Elements and Their Bacterial Hosts Emily Lauryn Clark, 2021 Integrative and conjugative elements ICEs are widespread mobile genetic elements that facilitate the spread of many important genes including those involved in antibiotic resistance metabolism pathogenesis or symbiosis These elements are also powerful tools for genetic analyses and engineering ICEs are typically found integrated in a host chromosome Either stochastically or upon some signal they can excise undergo DNA

processing events be transferred through encoded conjugation machinery into a neighboring cell and stably integrate into the new chromosome Interactions between an ICE and its hosts throughout the life cycle can influence the efficiency of acquisition by new hosts In this work I investigated and compared the interactions that two ICEs Tn916 and ICEBs1 have with their host cells First I explored how the different functional modules of these elements impact how efficiently they are transferred into different host species I generated hybrid conjugative elements that merge functions of both elements to increase transfer efficiencies presenting exciting potential to be used for genetic engineering Next I investigated a previously unknown ability of Tn916 to cause a growth arrest and kill its host cell I took genetic approaches to determine that two Tn916 encoded genes interact with a defective phage like element in the B subtilis chromosome to elicit some of these effects Finally I evaluated the integration site selection of Tn916 in the B subtilis chromosome identifying several hundred unique AT rich insertion sites one of which is a hot spot for integration I found that a host nucleoid associated protein does not influence integration site selection I conclude this body of work with a discussion of how the efficient spread of an element is shaped by its interactions with host cells and other horizontally acquired elements
