ATHENS, April 26—U.S. and Greek officials today agreed to end the 6th Fleet's presence in the Aegean Sea, a move that would end the fleet's 20-year mission to guard the straits of the Dardanelles and the Bosporus.

The fleet, which has been based in Greece since 1954, will be moved to the Mediterranean Sea, where it will be based at the port of Haifa, Israel. The fleet's mission will be to guard the straits of the Dardanelles and the Bosporus, and to provide a deterrent to Soviet forces in the region.

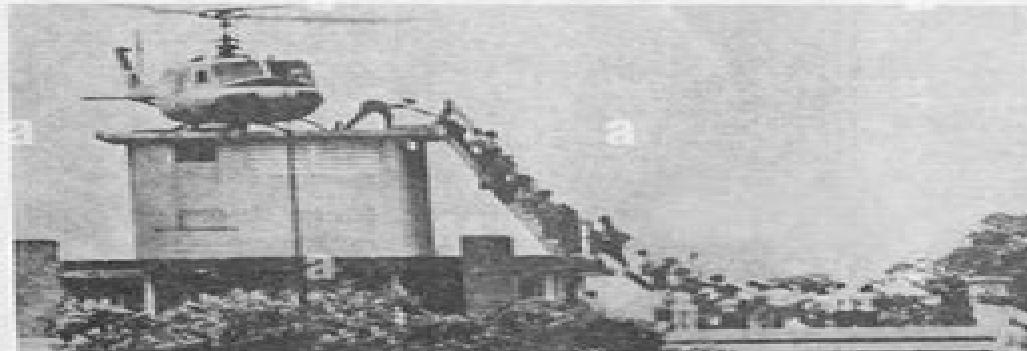
