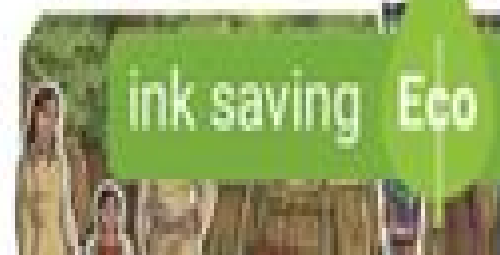


The moon is not only a beautiful object in the sky but also holds special meanings in different cultures. Let's explore some stories about the moon and why it's important to people!
