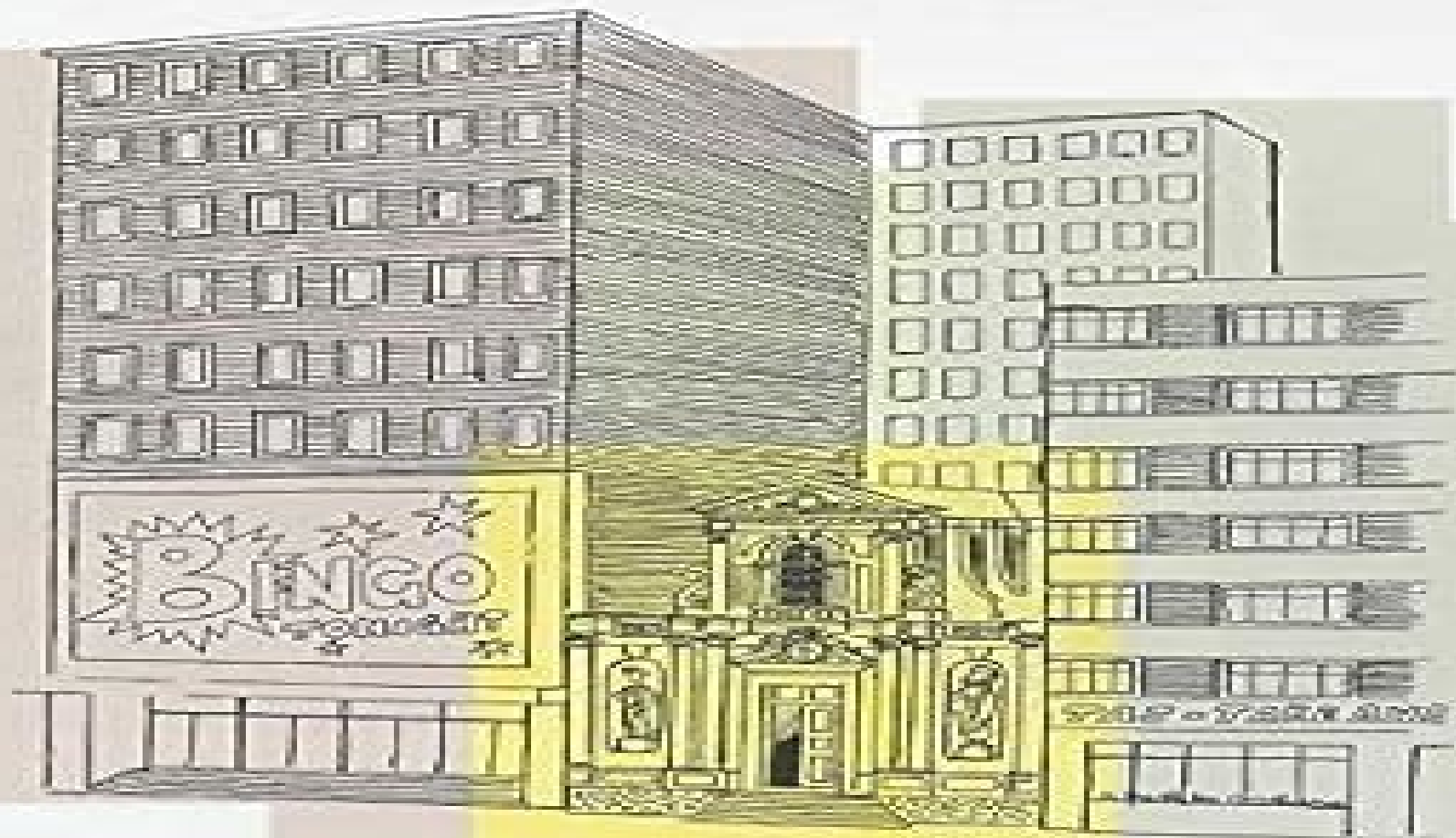

An editorial in *Apollo* entitled 'The Time Bomb' claimed that it deserved to become a set book in art school and University art history departments and the *Times Literary Supplement* savaged it as an example of that kind of vindictiveness of which only Christians seem capable. Any critic of such ethical, mechanical and populist fallacies was labelled anti-social and immoral. The book rapidly became a cult text. And here it is again with for the first time the story of its impact. Only covertly did the giants of the architectural establishment, men like Sir John Summerson, Sir Denys Lasdun, Sir Ove Arup, Sir Karl Popper and Sir Ernst Gombrich, support the author. Watkin goes on to give an overview of what has happened since and summarizes the situation today arguing that many of the old fallacies still persist.
