Oskar Panizza Peter D. G. Brown, 1983 This is the first book to critically examine the life and literature of Oskar Panizza 1853 1921 the most audacious and irreverent of the Munich Moderns associated with Michael Georg Conrad in the 1890 s Although this psychiatrist from Bad Kissingen wrote volumes of poetry fiction and polemics Panizza is best known for his play *Das Liebeskonzil* 1894 His scandalous heavenly tragedy depicts the origin of syphilis as the vengeance of an impotent yet vindictive God His retribution for the sexual excesses practiced at the Vatican Court of Rodrigo Borgia Pope Alexander VI 1495 Panizza s subsequent sentence to one year in prison on 93 counts of blasphemy sparked a major public debate about religion literary freedom and Wilhelminian censorship in which Theodor Fontane Detlev von Liliencron Thomas Mann Kurt Tucholsky and Frank Wedekind among others participated
