literature With an estimated number of at the most 10 000 Normans that settled in England as a result of the conquest and a native English population of at least 1 000 000 people it is unlikely that the use of language changed profoundly for the majority of the native speakers after the conquest Gradually the new language was assimilated by the English language It can therefore be argued that the Norman influence gave new life to the English language by releasing it from official constraints and then by enriching its vocabulary with numerous words derived from French and Latin but it did not cause a radical change in the language s use or structure This argument is confirmed by the fact that with the mass of people having problems to understand the new leading churchmen from the Normandy a rapid production of collections of homilies and other religious writings in English was necessary during the years after the Norman
