He supports this claim by showing that all the other objects of people's desire are either means to happiness or included in the definition of happiness Mill explains at length that the sentiment of justice is actually based on utility and that rights exist only because they are necessary for human happiness The theory of utilitarianism has been criticized for many reasons Critics hold that it does not provide adequate protection for individual rights that not everything can be measured by the same standard and that happiness is more complex than reflected by the theory Mill's essay represents his attempt to respond to these criticisms and thereby to provide a more complex and nuanced moral theory Mill's argument comprises five chapters His first chapter serves as an introduction to the essay In his second chapter Mill discusses the definition of utilitarianism and presents some misconceptions about the theory The third chapter is a discussion about the ultimate sanctions or rewards that utilitarianism can offer The fourth chapter discusses methods of proving the validity of utilitarianism In his fifth chapter Mill writes about the connection between justice and utility and argues that happiness is the foundation of justice [An Introduction to Mill's Utilitarian Ethics](#) Henry R.
