Breaking new ground Nelson reveals how gender and race mediated the aesthetic and scientific access of such mainly white male artists. She analyzes this moment of deep political crisis for British slave owners between the end of the slave trade in 1807 and complete abolition in 1833 who employed visual culture to imagine spaces free of conflict and to alleviate their pervasive anxiety about slave resistance. Nelson explores how vision and cartographic knowledge translated into authority which allowed colonizers to civilize the terrains of the so-called New World while belying the oppression of slavery and indigenous displacement.
