

**tragedy:** creative retelling of a myth

**tragic hero:** Internal struggling, intake communal suffering – Achilles struggles with his two fates – doomed to suffer

**peripeteia:** a turning point or reversal of circumstances/fortune

**hamartia:** the mistake (not necessarily a fatal flaw)

**anagnorisis:** the discovery/recognition

**chorus:** viewpoint of community

**deus ex machina:** hand of god to fix plot: indirect or direct punishment of hubris

**Tantalus:** Steals nectar & ambrosia and/or serves gods flesh of son Pelops, punished in Tartarus, gods restore Pelops\*

**Pelops:** wins hand of Hippodamia by winning a chariot race vs her father Oenomaus

→ Myrtilus helps him win by sabotaging after promise to share kingdom wife →

Pelops throws Myrtilus from a cliff, who curses his family as he falls to his death

**Hippodamia:**

**Atreus + Thyestes:** Atreus wins throne of Mycenae/Argos after a lengthy quarrel between

brothers. – **Thyestes** seduces **Atreus'** wife **Aerope**. **Atreus** finds out. – **Atreus** invites **Thyestes** & two his sons to dinner to reconcile. **Atreus** kills the sons and serves them to **Thyestes**.

**Aegisthus:** killed by orestes

**Clytemnestra:** killed by orestes + Orestes mother

**Orestes:** avenged father, Agememnon, by killing clytemnestra = furies prosecute for matricide =

Apollo defends actions = found innocent by athena

**Electra:** Orestes' sister, who conspires with **Orestes** to sneak him into the palace

**The Oresteia:** trilogy by Aeschylus

I. **Agamemnon:** king of Mycenae; helps spartans

II. **Libation Bearers:** Deaths of Aegisthus and Clytemnestra

**Orestes**, now of age, is commanded by Apollo to avenge his father **Agamemnon** –

Reunion with sister **Electra**, who conspires with **Orestes** to sneak him into the palace

– **Orestes** kills Aegisthus, then a pleading **Clytemnestra** after some hesitation -

**Orestes** is pursued by the Furies

III. **The Eumenides** (renamed from Athens): Trial of Orestes

**Orestes** goes to Delphi to be purified – **Apollo** commands him to seek sanctuary in

Athens – **Athena** presides over a trial – **Chorus of Furies:** plaintiffs – **Orestes:**

defendant – **Apollo:** his advocate – **Jury:** Elders of the **Areopagus** – **Orestes**

declared innocent after **Athena** casts tie-breaker vote – **Athena** appeases Furies by

establishing a cult for them in Athens, now called Eumenides
