Where to start before starting?

Not required reading by any means but at least getting a cursory overview of Nietzsche's most important influences will certainly give you a much deeper understanding of his work.



Start Here

A solid little book. It was intended by a older Nietzsche to be a summary or primer for his major ideas. Either read this first or skip it entirely.



As Nietzsche's earliest work is *Ecce Homo* the groundwork for a lot of what he will refine and extrapolate on later. While not absolutely necessary it offers a lot of insight and key points that are referenced but not reiterated in his later works. You will not really get Nietzsche without this book.

Start with either it really doesn't matter. Beyond was the first work and is the backbone of his corpus. Genealogy was intended to be more nearly traditional exploration of the ideas he introduced aphoristically in *Beyond*. However, this also makes *Genealogy* much easier to read and understand. As long as you read both before continuing you will be fine.



Here Nietzsche offers his most explicit and direct attack against Christ and Christianity. One of Nietzsche's easier texts.



A very interesting essay and the closest Nietzsche gets to an epistemology. If you're used to more traditional philosophy then this will likely be a book for you.

Though chronologically one of his earlier works it is better understood through the lens of his main work. Nietzsche offers his views on the modern world and modern culture more here than anywhere else.



An early and unfinished work. It offers fascinating look at the pre-socratic philosophers that are usually brushed aside in philosophy 101 to make room for the big three. Here Nietzsche takes their ideas seriously as pre-logical but salient metaphysical arguments.

A faux autobiography offering a number of aphoristic self-reflections. One of Nietzsche's last books in which he looks back and comments on all his previous work.
