In Aristotle it appears as an unresolved tension between form and matter. This basic split in Adorno's interpretation runs right through the history of metaphysics. Perhaps not surprisingly Adorno finds this tension resolved in the Hegelian dialectic. Underlying this dualism is a further dichotomy which Adorno sees as essential to metaphysics while it dissolves belief in transcendental worlds by thought at the same time it seeks to rescue belief in a reality beyond the empirical again by thought. It is to this profound ambiguity for Adorno that the metaphysical tradition owes its greatness. The major part of these lectures given by Adorno late in his life is devoted to a critical exposition of Aristotle's thought focusing on its central ambiguities. In the last lectures Adorno's attention switches to the question of the relevance of metaphysics today particularly after the Holocaust. He finds in
