which such images as golden light and mirror images are signs of the mother's presence as both Danae mother of Perseus and Medusa whom Perseus confronted Through pursuing sequential patterns as well as echoes and myth GhostlyParallels brings a wealth of insights to the work of this prolific novelist critic and essayist An important guide for undergraduate and graduate students alike Ghostly Parallels will also appeal to anyone with an interest in Robert Penn Warren and southern literature
