CLASS RESEARCH





Research conducted in class has backed up the conclusions of professional research. It was found that most agree with professional research in that violent media does encourage behavior and can even increase those behaviors the more one is exposed to them. However, there was still quite a few that disagreed, and said violent media has no real world effects.

REAL WORLD RESEARCH

Research has concluded that, yes, the violent media that we consume does translate to some extent to the real world. One study conducted that began in 2006 and ended in 2022 gauged the amount of violent behaviors watched in media, and then the amount of violent behavior performed in real life was assessed. There was a positive correlation between the two factors. Other studies have also confirmed this conclusion.

But make no mistake, the connection is there!
