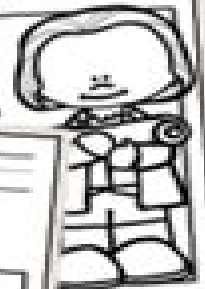

The Executive Branch is made up of the President, the Vice-President, and the Cabinet. The Cabinet is a group of people who advise the President.

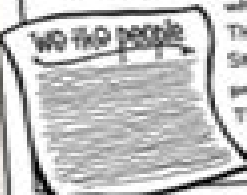
