Ling, 2006 Bosons are particles which form totally symmetric composite quantum states As a result they obey Bose Einstein statistics The spin statistics theorem states that bosons have integer spin Bosons are also the only particles which can occupy the same state as another All elementary particles are either bosons or fermions Gauge bosons are elementary particles which act as the carriers of the fundamental forces such as the W vector bosons of the weak force the gluons of the strong force the photons of the electromagnetic force and the graviton of the gravitational force Particles composed of a number of other particles such as protons or nuclei can be either fermions or bosons depending on their total spin Hence many nuclei are in fact bosons While fermions obey the Pauli exclusion principle no more than one fermion can occupy a single quantum state there is no exclusion property for bosons which are free to and indeed other things being equal tend to crowd into the same quantum state This explains the spectrum of black body radiation and the operation of lasers the properties of superfluid helium 4 and the possibility of bosons to form Bose Einstein condensates a particular state of matter It is important to note that Bose Einstein condensation occurs only at ultra low temperature There is nothing exotic about bosons otherwise At any reasonable temperatures both the boson and fermion particles behave as classical particles i e particle in a box and follow the Maxwell Boltzmann Statistics This book includes leading research from around the world
