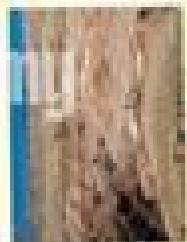


The Morrison formation

It represents one of the world's most important sites. It is the origin of thousands of late Jurassic fossil remains, some belonging to most popular dinosaurs. It is located in the United States and contains rocks that were deposited under an arid climate with seasonal rains.

Towards the end of the 19th century, the Morrison Formation was the site of the first large-scale paleontological excavations. The site was named after the greatest amount of fossils.



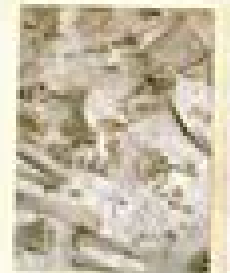

The fossils, deposited in a layer that is 100 feet thick, are evidence of a complex and diverse ecosystem affected by frequent cycles of rain and drought, and it is this that makes the Morrison Formation a site of interest.

FLORA

Seasonal rains and abundant vegetation contributed to the development of giant sauropods that became the largest ever.

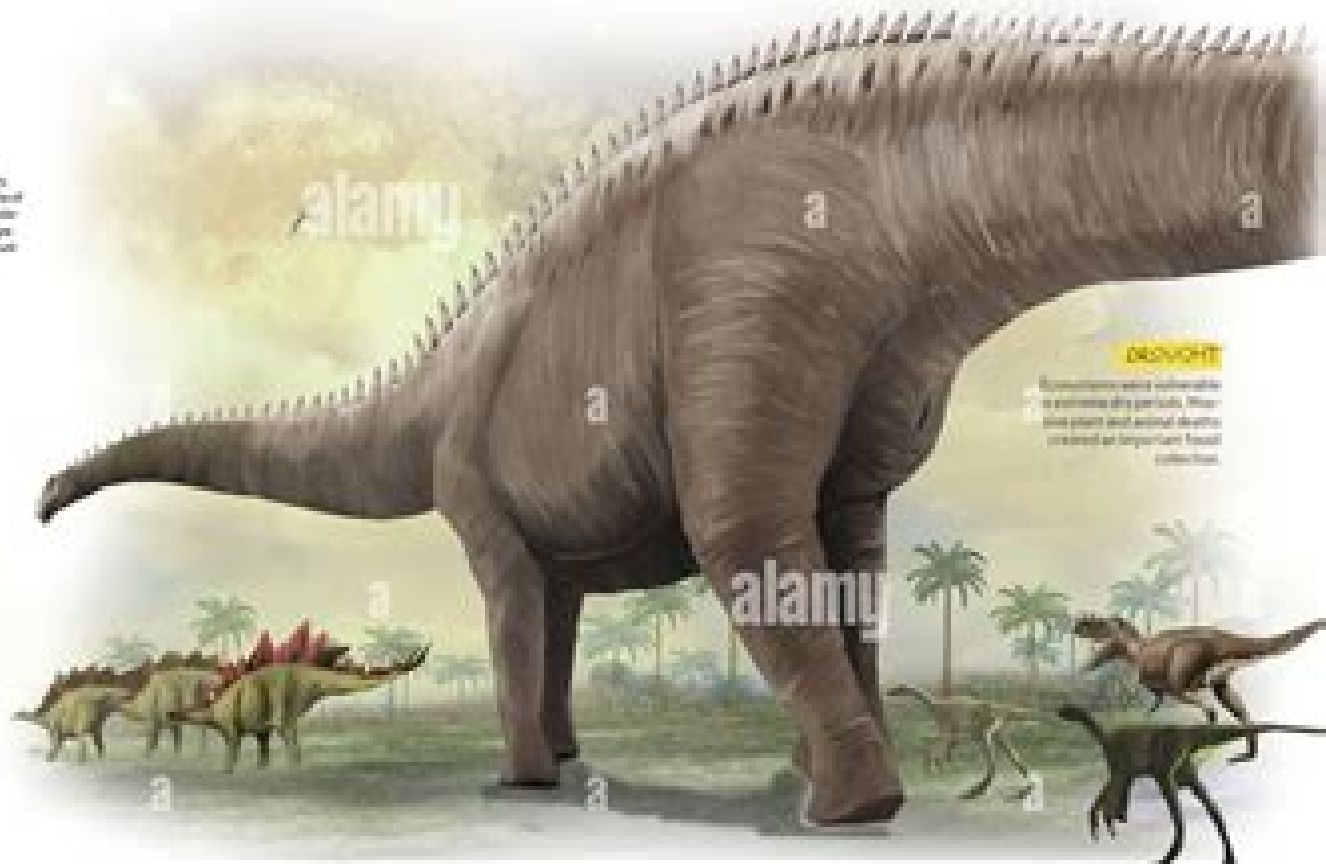
A NATURAL MONUMENT TO PREHISTORY
